## No hand-held cellphone use

**Effective September 1, 2009, drivers are not permitted to use hand-held cellphones while driving on Strathcona County-controlled roads.**

### Highlights of Cellular Phone Bylaw 27-2009

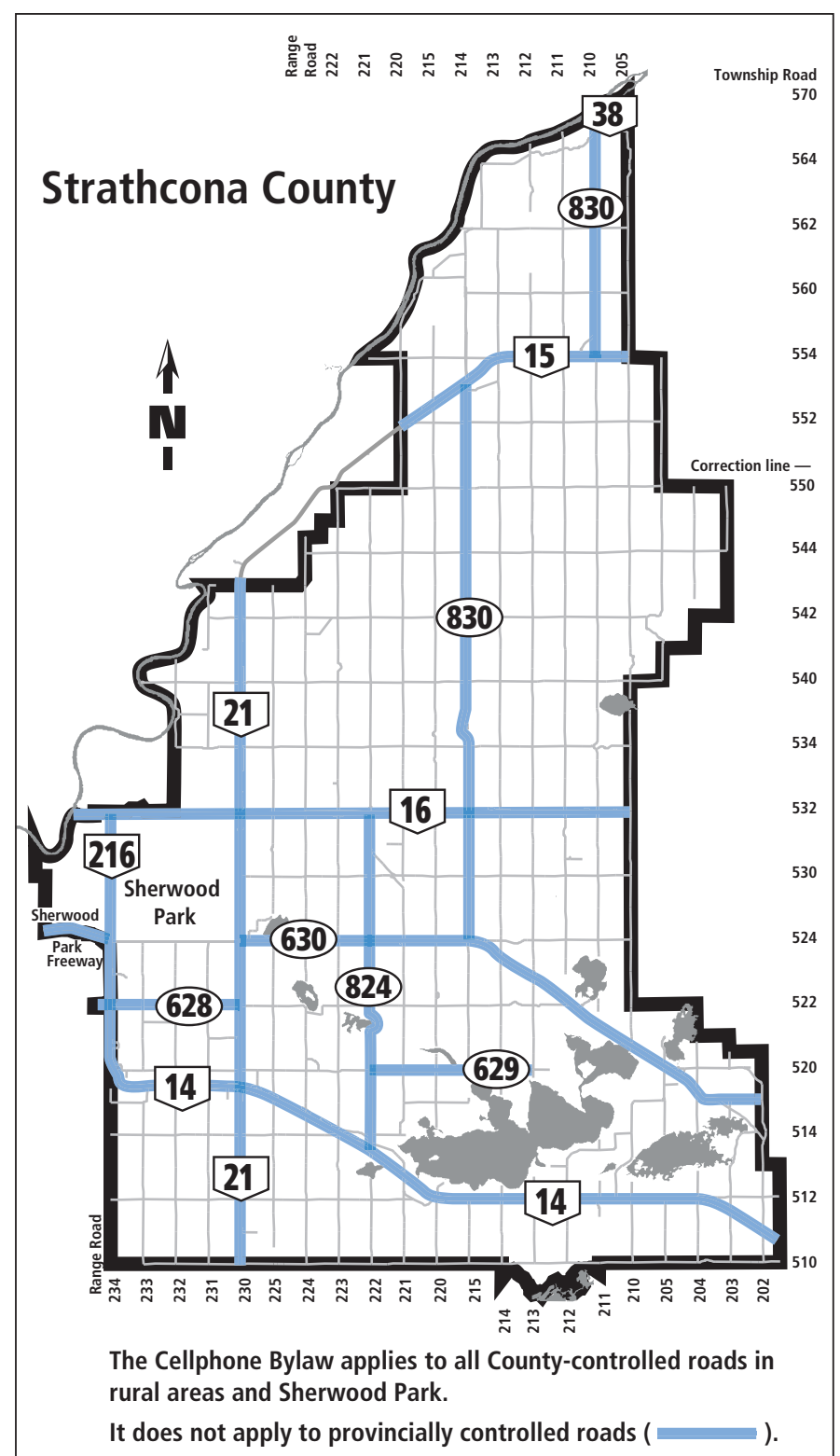
- "Using" a cellphone includes dialing, answering, talking, texting and listening.
- The bylaw is in effect for all County-controlled roads.
- The ban does not apply if a vehicle is parked.
- Drivers may use hands-free cellphones.
- Fines: \$100, first offence; \$200 for each subsequent offence.
